REGISTRATION INFORMATION

POLICY- Residents of the Borough of Point Pleasant can register beginning Tuesday, December 1st at 10AM. Non-residents can register starting Tuesday, December 8th at 10AM. Registration closes on December 15th at 5PM. Registration is available through the Community Pass online registration system with a credit or debit card. To set up an account visit www.ptboro.com/recreation and be sure to add all your family members. Check payments can be made in person only, made out to the Borough of Point Pleasant. The returned check fee is \$20. The Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel classes due to low enrollment. The Recreation Department reserves the right to remove a program participant for disciplinary problems and or violations of Recreation rules and policies. Refunds can be requested by email (ssilversmith@ptboro.com) until Tuesday, December 15th at 5PM. Refunds will only be issued by check in 45 days. Sneakers must be worn in gym for all programs unless otherwise noted. Children in “drop off” classes must be FULLY toilet trained meaning NO diapers or pull-ups. 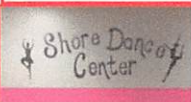

Parents can purchase a lifetime account for \$27 from Mojang (www.minecraft.net/en-us/store/minecraft-java-edition) When we connect using the ZOOM app it makes it easier for the children to communicate virtually while they are in class as well as for us to help students with questions and/or problems.

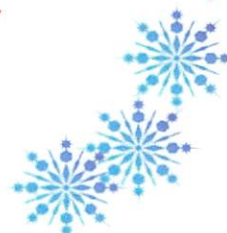

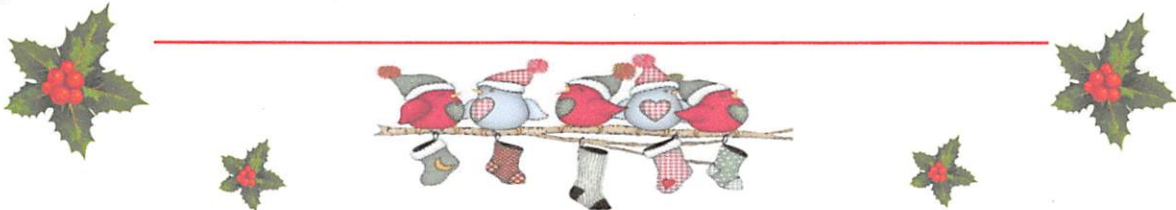


Family Gingerbread House Contest
