ORDINANCE NO. 2026-07
NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Borough of Point Pleasant, in the County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, on May 18, 2026. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the Municipal Building, 2233 Bridge Avenue, Point Pleasant, New Jersey on June 22, 2026, at 7:00 o'clock PM. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who request the same. This ordinance shall be available for public examination in the Office of the Borough Clerk during normal business hours and is also published in summary on the Borough website www.ptboro.com on the homepage under "*Public Notices*". The summary of the ordinance is as follows:

TITLE:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF POINT PLEASANT, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND OTHER RELATED EXPENSES IN AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF POINT PLEASANT AND APPROPRIATING \$1,944,971 THEREFOR, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,846,971 IN BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH OF POINT PLEASANT TO FINANCE THE SAME

PURPOSES:

- (a) Acquisition of information technology and telecommunications equipment, including items with a unit cost less than \$5,000, including, but not limited to, various computer upgrades at Borough Hall, portable radios for First Aid, mobile radios for the Fire Department, and body cameras for the Police Department;
- (b) Acquisition of equipment, including, but not limited to, stormwater materials including grates, castings, manhole covers and ecoplates for the Department of Public Works, towable light tower for the Office of Emergency Management, various equipment for the Dive Squad, vehicle extraction equipment for the Fire Department, and radar speed signs, body armor, rifles, badges and uniform items and taser for the Police Department;
- (c) Acquisition of fire truck for the Fire Department, including apparatus and equipment;
- (d) Acquisition of turn out gear, fire hose and self-contained breathing apparatus for the Fire Department;
- (e) Road reconstruction to at least a Class B standard, as provided in the Local Bond Law, including, but not limited to, Comanche Road, construction of sidewalks and various milling and paving projects;
- (f) Sand replacement at Borough beaches;

(g) Capital improvements to Borough properties and buildings, including, without limitation, updating DPW facilities, drainage improvements on various Borough roads, and replacing fencing at Community Park;

(h) Acquisition of vehicles including vehicles with a gross vehicle weight below 15,000 pounds, including the original apparatus and equipment therefor, and including, but not limited to, vehicles for the Police Department; and including all work and materials necessary therefor or incidental thereto.
