NOTICE OF PENDING ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the foregoing Ordinance and the summary of terms which are included herein, was introduced and passed by the Borough Council of the Borough of Pleasant Borough on first reading at a meeting held on the 20th day of July, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. The Ordinance will be considered for second and final reading at a meeting of the Borough Council which is scheduled for the 17th day of August 2026 at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be reached, at the Municipal Building located at 2233 Bridge Avenue, Point Pleasant, New Jersey, at which time the public is invited to ask questions, raise objections, or provide public comment with regard to the proposed adoption of this Ordinance. This ordinance shall be available for public examination in the Office of the Borough Clerk during normal business hours and is also published in summary on the Borough website www.ptboro.com on the homepage under “*Public Notices*”. The summary of the ordinance is as follows:

**TITLE: AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF POINT PLEASANT,
COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, REPEALING
AND REPLACING CHAPTER 7-25 ENTITLED “DESIGNATED
HANDICAPPED PARKING ON SCHOOL STREET,” SECTION
25.4, ENTITLED “PENALTIES AND VIOLATIONS”**

PURPOSE:

SECTION 1. Borough Code Section 7-25.4 is repealed in its entirety and replaced as follows:

§25.4. Penalties for Violations.

Any person found violating the provisions of this Section shall be subject to the penalties under N.J.S.A. 39:4-203 and 39:4207.7.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable. If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid for any reason by any Court or competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be limited in its effect only to the portion of the Ordinance actually adjudged invalid and shall not be deemed to affect the operation of any other portion thereof, which shall remain in full force and effect.
