NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at a meeting of the Borough of Point Pleasant, in the County of Ocean, New Jersey held on the 17th day of August 2026, the following ordinance was adopted on final passage. This ordinance is published in summary on the Borough website www.ptboro.com on the homepage under “*Public Notices*”. The summary of the ordinance is as follows:

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF POINT PLEASANT, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, REPEALING AND REPLACING CHAPTER 7-25 ENTITLED “DESIGNATED HANDICAPPED PARKING ON SCHOOL STREET,” SECTION 25.4, ENTITLED “PENALTIES AND VIOLATIONS”

PURPOSE:

SECTION 1. Borough Code Section 7-25.4 is repealed in its entirety and replaced as follows:

§25.4. Penalties for Violations.

Any person found violating the provisions of this Section shall be subject to the penalties under N.J.S.A. 39:4-203 and 39:4207.7.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable. If any portion of this Ordinance is found to be invalid for any reason by any Court or competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall be limited in its effect only to the portion of the Ordinance actually adjudged invalid and shall not be deemed to affect the operation of any other portion thereof, which shall remain in full force and effect.
