NOTICE OF PENDING ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the foregoing Ordinance and the summary of terms which are included herein, was introduced and passed by the Borough Council of the Borough of Pleasant Borough on first reading at a meeting held on the 17th day of August, 2026, at 7:00 p.m. The Ordinance will be considered for second and final reading at a meeting of the Borough Council which is scheduled for the 21st day of September 2026 at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be reached, at the Municipal Building located at 2233 Bridge Avenue, Point Pleasant, New Jersey, at which time the public is invited to ask questions, raise objections, or provide public comment with regard to the proposed adoption of this Ordinance. This ordinance shall be available for public examination in the Office of the Borough Clerk during normal business hours and is also published in summary on the Borough website www.ptboro.com on the homepage under “Public Notices”. The summary of the ordinance is as follows:

**TITLE: CREATING AND ESTABLISHING BOROUGH CODE
CHAPTER 7A-21, ENTITLED "SCHEDULE XXI:
RESIDENT HANDICAPPED ON-STREET PARKING
SPACES" AND GRANTING THE PLACEMENT OF A
RESIDENT HANDICAPPED ON-STREET PARKING
SPACE IN FRONT OF PROPERTY COMMONLY KNOWN
AS 1113 BARTON AVENUE.**

PURPOSE:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created Borough Code Chapter 7A-21, entitled “Schedule XXI: Resident Handicapped On-street Parking Spaces,” and shall read as follows:

In accordance with the provisions of Section 7-14A, the following described sections of streets are hereby designated as resident handicapped on-street parking spaces:

Address	Location
1113 Barton Avenue	Directly in front of residence

SECTION 2. The location of this resident handicapped on-street parking space shall be for the benefit of the current occupant of 1113 Barton Avenue. Such handicapped on-street parking space shall apply only to the current residents of 1113 Barton Avenue and shall not run with the land.
